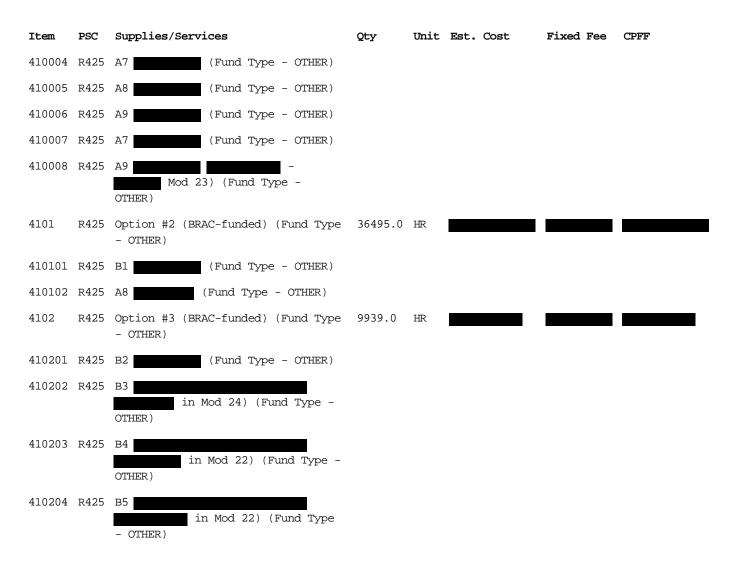

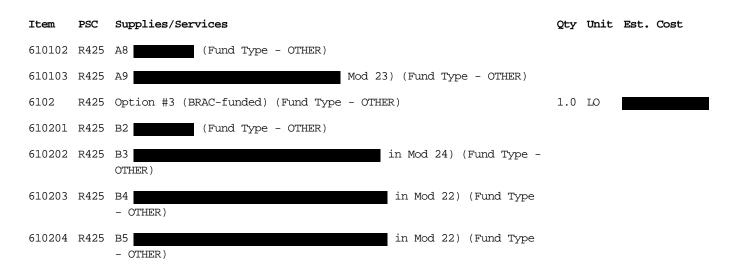

- (b) In the event that the incurred level of effort exceeds by 5% or less of the task order requirement, but does not exceed the estimated cost of the task order, the Contractor shall be entitled to cost reimbursement for actual hours expended, not to exceed the ceiling cost. The Contractor shall not be paid fixed fee, however, on level of effort in excess of 100% without complying with subsection (d) below. This understanding does not supersede or change subsection (d) below, whereby the Contractor and Government may agree on a change to the task order level of effort with an equitable adjustment for both cost and fee.

The Sensors and Sonar Systems Department (Code 15) at NUWCDIVNPT is the principal agent for subsurface maritime sensors and sonar systems, research, analysis, development, integration, test, acquisition, and life-cycle support.

Within the 2005 Base Realignment Closure Committee (BRAC) Bill, approved by the President, NUWCDIVNPT is identified as a gaining activity. Subsurface sensor work at three locations (SPAWAR Systems Center San Diego, Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division Patuxent River, and SPAWAR Charleston) is to be relocated to NUWCDIVNPT, Code 15.

#### 2.0 SCOPE:

The contractor shall provide engineering and administrative services relating to the BRAC 2005 transition to NUWCDIVNPT.

#### 4.0 REQUIREMENTS

The work to be performed falls within the scope of basic Seaport-E Statement of Work paragraphs 3.8, 3.9, 3.10, 3.11, 3.20, and 3.21.

4.1 Analysis of Maritime Undersea Sensors and Sonar Systems Functions

The contractor shall analyze subject work being performed at the "losing sites" and shall identify the specific nature of this work, the sponsoring activity, and the funding profile. The contractor shall make recommendations as to how/where this work fits into the organizational structure at NUWCDIVNPT.

The contractor shall provide concurrent support in accordance with the applicable documents in Section 3.0 to operations being transitioned during the phases of dismantling, movement and reinstallation of equipment such that operations may continue during the time of transition. This support shall be provided at the "losing site" and the "gaining site" (see para. 4.4 above for additional information).
